

FIRST CIRCULAR Call for Session Proposals

The **University of Granada** will host the **20th Congress of the Spanish Society for Agrarian History (SEHA)**, to be held on **June 23, 24 and 25, 2027**. In this edition, the central focus will revolve around issues related to **history, politics, and power in the rural world**—a cross-cutting theme through which to understand **agrarian history** and its historical evolution, offering interpretative insights into present-day challenges.

Given the **richness and complexity** of this approach, the congress will pay special attention to the **economic, cultural, political, and gender dimensions** that shape the rural world. Nevertheless, in keeping with SEHA's open spirit, sessions may address any other line of research related to agrarian history and the rural world.

With this circular, the call for proposals for thematic sessions is now open. **Proposals must include the following information:**

- Session title
- Organizer(s) (maximum of 3), clearly indicating one contact person
- An abstract of up to 500 words describing the session topic
- A provisional list of participants and paper titles (minimum of 4)
